## Executive Board Actions Taken at June 3, 2008 Meeting

### 2009 Legislative Agenda: Work Begins

- July's Executive Board meeting: brainstorm issues for Agenda.
- Staff will gather input from Kitsap-related agencies & lobbyists.
- September/October to refine the Agenda.
- November Executive Board Meeting: Anticipate adoption, prior to November 20 Legislative Dinner.
- Presentation packet: Left pocket/Right pocket for Local /Countywide legislative issues.
- KRCC needs *point of contact* for each member jurisdiction.

### Accessory Dwelling Units Seen as Help for Affordable Housing *(see KRCC website for ADU chart & PowerPoint presentation)*

- Focus: Lower end of market-rate (non-subsidized) housing spectrum. Planning Directors Forum compared County & Cities' rules on ADU's (Accessory Dwelling Units).
- *Next up:* What other Reasonable Measures are particularly applicable to improving affordability? Anticipate presentation at September Executive Board meeting.
- *Board interest* in possibility of Planning Directors' developing guidelines ~ Board members will check with their Councils!

### Low Income Housing Grant Program: Next Cycle to Begin Next Month

- The Executive Board approved Funding Priorities and the Application Review Committee for Cycle 6 of the Affordable Housing For All Grant Program based on document recording fees. Approximately \$310,000 will be available for local grants.
- Bidder's Conference is July 3, 2008.
- *Related:* Expect recommendations from Grant Programs' 3 Year Review Committee at July 1 Board Meeting.

### Transportation Funding Approved

Federal Transportation Funding for Kitsap in the total amount of \$1,024,166 is available for distribution in 2008, through the Puget Sound Regional Council.

There are some requirements:

- \$238,535 to federally-designated Non-Urban Areas (*i.e.* outside Kitsap's Urban Growth Areas)
- \$177,280 to be used for Non-Motorized transportation facilities
- \$608,351 is unencumbered, *i.e.* can be used for any transportation projects already on the Regional Transportation Improvement Program list

Funds can be used now or held for programming during 2009 for the next federal cycle (2011-2013).

The starting point for project selection thru KRCC's Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TransTAC) was the Contingency List approved in 2006 as part of the 2008-2010 cycle; the TransTAC updated those projects' information and made recommendations, which the KRCC's Transportation Policy Committee (TransPol) reviewed & finalized, for consideration by the KRCC Executive Board. The Board approved the following projects for funding:

- ❖ Port Orchard's Tremont Street Widening right of way acquisition:  
\$177,280 for **Non-Motorized** portion +  
\$ 90,644 for other portions (**unencumbered**)
- ❖ Bremerton SR 303 Corridor: Warren Ave & 11<sup>th</sup> Street intersection: \$222,048 for engineering
- ❖ Bremerton Passenger Only Ferry Dock (A-Float): \$295,659 ~ completes project (**unencumbered**)
- ❖ Hold \$238,535 **Non-Urban Area** funds for 2011 - 2013 Cycle programming during 2009.
