A. WELCOME AND APPROVAL OF DRAFT MARCH 2018 MEETING SUMMARY

Betsy Daniels, KRCC Director, welcomed participants to the meeting (see Attachment A for a list of TransPOL members and observers). TransPOL approved the draft 3/15/2018 meeting summary as final.

B. 2018 KITSAP COUNTYWIDE COMPETITION

As part of the process for the Countywide Competition, the project sponsors provided presentations on their proposed projects. These projects will be reviewed by the KRCC Board on May 1. Projects recommended for funding will be approved by the Board on June 5. The projects are competing for \$9.42 million and have a combined funding request of \$28,332,000. Below is a list of the proposed projects and points of clarification from the subsequent questions by TransPOL. Please visit the KRCC website to view the projects' supporting documents.

 Bainbridge Island: Bucklin Hill Road Phase 2 Request: \$600,000

2. Bainbridge Island: Eagle Harbor Drive Phase

Request: \$700,000

3. Bainbridge Island: Madison Sidewalk Improvements

Request: \$270,000

4. Bremerton: 6th Street Preservation Phase 2

Request: \$865,000

5. Bremerton: Washington & 11th Improvements

Request: \$4,200,000

Clarifications: Local access is maintained. The elevation transition is 4ft. Bike lanes are included.

6. Kitsap County: Bethel Burley Road Culvert

Request: \$340,000

7. Kitsap County: Central Valley Road

Request: \$2,400,000

Clarifications: The sidewalk and bike line will be extended to the elementary school in a separate phase.

8. Kitsap County: Markwick Trail

Request: \$860,000

Clarifications: The length of the trail is 0.7 miles. The foot path will be a paved surface.

9. Kitsap County: National STEM School

Request: \$2,000,000

10. Kitsap County: Olalla Valley Road

Request: \$582,000

11. Kitsap County: Ridgetop Mickelberry to Myhre

Request: \$2,100,000

Clarifications: Amenities near the site include Best Buy, Trader Joes and the Silverdale Hospital. Phase 1 will inform the cost of the other three phases but the total cost of all phases is estimated to be \$36 million (extrapolated from a 2005 study). The area has the highest growth projections in the County.

12. Kitsap Transit: Gateway Bus Storage Facility and Park

Request: \$5,000,000

Clarifications: The proposed site is located at 6th and Montgomery.

13. Kitsap Transit: SR 16 Park & Ride

Request: \$500,000

Clarifications: The Park & Ride would not service Banghor but would service the new routes in Kingston

and Poulsbo.

14. Kitsap Transit: SR 104 and Bond Park & Ride

Request: \$4,600,000

15. Kitsap Transit: SR 166 Park & Ride Expansion

Request: \$900,000

16. Port Orchard: Bay St. Pedestrian Pathway West Situational

Request: \$490,000

Clarifications: All 18 culverts will eventually need to be replaced. The original estuary will need to be

recreated, according to state mandate. Port Property is within the boundary of the project.

17. Poulsbo: Fjord Drive Preservation

Request: \$425,000

18. Poulsbo: SR 305 Tunnel Reguest: \$1,500,000

Clarifications: The design phase has already been funded.

Mayor Erickson thanked the group for their work and encouraged jurisdictions to consider how local funding can be improved. John Clauson added that projects are more competitive in funding competitions when they can prove a local match. Lynn Wall thanked project sponsors who coordinating with the Navy.

^{*}DRAFT funding amounts represented by the additional "STP" dollars coming to the region from the 2018 federal spending bill (they're not technically STP dollars but PSRC has been told to treat them as such). Following PSRC's standard procedure for additional funding to the region, PSRC is not changing the set-aside amounts but rather applying a straight population percentage among the four counties. The funds will be distributed via the FAST Act population categories, so there will be an increase to the rural amounts. These new funds must be obligated no later than September 30, 2021, and therefore only apply to the 2021 funding pots. The DRAFT estimates (as of 5/25/18) are that Kitsap will receive an increase of \$292,000, with an increase to the rural set-aside amount by \$30,000.




