A. Welcome and Business

Sophie Glass welcomed meeting participants (see Attachment A: List of LUTAC Members in Attendance).

LUTAC approved their March 14, 2019 meeting summary as final.

KRCC Staff provided a verbal update to LUTAC members regarding the KRCC Affordable Housing Task Force (AHTF) meeting held on March 21, 2019. At the March 21 AHTF meeting, participants focused on affordable housing policy tools and reviewed the process for potentially issuing a state of emergency for affordable housing.

B. Buildable Lands Presentation and Discussion

Sophie Glass introduced Peter Best, Senior Planner (Kitsap County) and Kristen Howard, Associate Planner (Kitsap County). Peter and Kristen provided a presentation to LUTAC members about the Kitsap County Growth Management Act Review and Evaluation Program. This presentation focused on new 2018 Department of Commerce Buildable Lands Guidelines.

LUTAC members posed questions and expressed concerns about conducting land capacity analyses and meeting the deliverables for the next Buildable Lands Report. The expected completion date for the next Buildable Lands Report is the end of 2021.

C. Amendments to Kitsap Countywide Planning Policies (CPPs)

LUTAC members discussed the potential next steps to amend the Kitsap CPPs. LUTAC members reviewed a memo prepared by Nick Bond (City of Port Orchard) and Jim Bolger (Kitsap County) regarding the Kitsap CPPs. LUTAC members provided comments on the memo, discussed differing points of interest, and noted areas of agreement.

LUTAC members reviewed the potential process moving forward if (a) LUTAC was able to reach consensus on recommendations to PlanPOL regarding the Kitsap CPPs, and if (b) LUTAC was not able to reach consensus on the Kitsap CPPs recommendations.

LUTAC reached agreement on having criteria for Countywide Centers in the Kitsap CPPs that aligns and is consistent with PSRC criteria. LUTAC recommended drafting the criteria in language that fits the character of Kitsap. LUTAC recommended refining the language of the Kitsap CPPs and discussing the potential for Local Centers as topics for the May 9 meeting.

D. Review Approach for May 21 PlanPOL Meeting

LUTAC members recommended to continue the targeted updates to the Kitsap CPPs and strive to include criteria for countywide center designation, as well as refine language in the Kitsap CPPs.

E. Wrap Up and Next Steps

The next PlanPOL meeting is scheduled for May 21. The next LUTAC meeting will be on May 9.
