### A. WELCOME AND OLD BUSINESS

Sophie Glass, KRCC Program Lead, welcomed participants to the KRCC Transportation Policy Committee (TransPOL) virtual meeting (see Attachment A for a list of TransPOL members and observers). The April 21, 2022 TransPOL meeting summary was approved with one update to correct the position of Director Clauson of Kitsap Transit. Sophie reviewed the agenda, topics of discussion, and purpose of the meeting.

### **B. 2022 FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION COMPETITIONS**

Sophie reviewed the outcomes of the Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) Regional Transportation Competition. Sophie then provided a brief overview of the TransTAC Project Selection Workshop on May 31, 2022 and shared the recommended projects and contingency list for the 2022 Countywide Transportation Competition. TransPOL members approved the recommended projects and contingency list without abstention or opposition. TransPOL members commented on the high quality of the projects and presentations for the 2022 competition. The KRCC Board will have the opportunity to vote on these projects and contingency list during their June 2022 meeting.

### C. TRANSPORTATION POLICY BOARD AND OTHER PSRC UPDATES

The Regional Transportation Plan was passed on May 26, 2022.

### D. CORRIDOR UPDATES

TransPOL members provided updates on projects underway in their jurisdictions.

- The City of Poulsbo expects a ribbon cutting to be scheduled for the Johnson Parkway roundabout in the first or second week of September.
- The City of Poulsbo presented on the multimodal capacity of the Sound to Olympic trail to Leafline, a statewide and regional trail organization. The project is expected to be complete in September.
- Work is occurring along the Bremerton corridors, but there are no major milestones approaching.
- The City of Port Orchard shared about their research on Transportation Benefit Districts (TBDs), which changed in the last legislative session. Voter-approved TBDs can last 20 years with bonding, and council approved TBDs last 10 years with bonding. TBDs are available to cities.

Sophie Glass opened the public comment portion of the meeting. No public comments were made. The next TransPOL meeting will be on October 20, 2022.
