1. Chair's Welcome

KRCC Chair/Kitsap County Commissioner Rob Gelder welcomed the Executive Committee to the virtual meeting.

2. Committee Updates and Action Items

A. Executive Committee Items

Approve the June 16 Executive Committee meeting summary

Mayor Deets moved to approve the June 16 Executive Committee meeting summary. Mayor Erickson seconded. The summary was unanimously approved as drafted.

Decide virtual/hybrid formats for October public meetings

The Executive Committee reviewed information regarding the lifting of the State of Emergency and Governor's executive orders around COVID 19 that take effect 10/31/22, public meeting health protocol recommendations provided by Kitsap Public Health District, and the plans of other Kitsap Boards for in-person and virtual attendance options for upcoming October 4 Board meetings. Members anticipated that upcoming changes to state requirements for open public meetings may soon return to requiring in-person meetings. They discussed the value and their preferences for meeting in person for decision making and their desire to be present and accessible to members of the public. They also noted the benefits of preserving an online participation option for those who cannot attend in person due to illness, quarantine, or travel. The committee also discussed looking into having TransPOL meet at Kitsap Transit offices instead of at NDGC, but staff recommended staying with the existing arrangement at NDGC for the one remaining meeting of this year.

The Executive Committee decided to hold the 10/4 Board meeting in a hybrid format, with in-person participation at Norm Dicks Government Center (NDGC) Chambers and options for remote participation via Zoom. Board Members will be encouraged to attend in person but may attend virtually if needed. Members of the public may attend the meeting and offer public comment either in person at NDGC or virtually via Zoom according to their individual preference. The 10/20 TransPOL meeting will remain virtual with an option for public viewing of the livestream of the meeting at NDGC Chambers.

Review Draft 2023 KRCC Work Plan

KRCC staff introduced the draft KRCC work plan for 2023. Since Countywide Planning Policies (CPPs) and growth targets are complete and 2023 is not the major Surface Transportation Program (STP) transportation competition year, staff anticipate that 2023 will involve a lighter workload than 2022 in both land use and transportation. TransTAC has reviewed the plan and PlanPOL will review it September 20. Members discussed potentially focusing KRCC time on learning together, with technical committees exploring issues around topics such as new housing target requirements, rural town center requirements, climate change issues, and other areas of research.

The Committee recommended updates to the proposed 2023 KRCC meeting calendar in response to work plan items. KRCC staff will check the proposed calendar for compatibility with major religious holidays.

Discuss 2022 KRCC Legislative Reception

Members discussed plans for the 2022 legislative reception. Members expressed a preference for an in-person reception this year. They noted that since there are not local elections this year and since WSAC and AWC are hosting an orientation session in early December, the legislative orientation may not be needed this year.

Members proposed that the Legislative Reception be held in person on Wednesday, November 30 as a happy hour starting around 4pm and include a panel discussion with legislators. Chair Gelder will reach out to Chairman Sullivan to ask whether Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe would host the event at The Point Casino. The theme of the reception will be "Celebrating 30 Years of Regional Cooperation." KRCC staff will coordinate logistics and invitations for the event and will work with Executive Committee members to develop discussion topics/questions for the panel.

<u>Discuss KRCC 30th anniversary logo/celebration</u>

The Executive Committee revisited the topic of redesigning the KRCC logo. While members shared that they are not thrilled with the current logo and would be open to changes, the Committee agreed that for now there is not a strong preference for redesigning the logo.

B. Land Use Items

• Information: 9/20 PlanPOL meeting agenda

At the 9/20 PlanPOL meeting, members will review the draft 2023 KRCC work plan. The Committee decided that LUTAC should receive Department of Commerce presentation on HB 1220 before PlanPOL and recommend whether the content would be useful for the policy committee, so, KRCC Staff will cancel Commerce's September presentation to PlanPOL, and reschedule it for 2023 if LUTAC recommends. The 9/20 PlanPOL meeting will remain virtual with an option for public viewing of the livestream of the meeting at NDGC Chambers.

Review draft November 10 LUTAC draft meeting agenda

The LUTAC meeting date moved from Oct 13 to Nov 10 due to timing of the American Planning Association (APA) Washington conference that many members plan to attend. The Department of Commerce will present new guidance on HB 1220 regarding racially disparate impacts on housing. The 11/10 LUTAC meeting will be virtual-only via Zoom.

Review draft October 20 TransPOL meeting agenda

The 10/20 TransPOL meeting will remain virtual with an option for public viewing of the livestream of the meeting at NDGC Chambers.

3. Review KRCC Board Agenda and Materials

Review draft October 4 KRCC Board meeting agenda

The Committee reviewed the draft agenda for the October 4 KRCC Board meeting. They decided that Department of Commerce will not present to the Board on October 4.

4. Administrative Agenda

• Discuss Triangle Associates contract renewal process

The Executive Committee confirmed that the 2023-4 Triangle contract should go through an approval process involving a formal vote of the full Board. The contract renewal should proceed in coordination with the development and approval process for the 2023 work plan, budget, and dues. The work plan, budget and dues should be reviewed by the Board in October for a vote in November. Chair Gelder will send the contract for legal review. The Executive Committee will review any updates to the contract to prepare it for the full Board to review at the November Board meeting and vote on approval at the December Board meeting.

• Discuss old MOU with Suguamish Tribe and Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe

Committee members discussed the history of the Memo of Understanding (MOU) between KRCC and the Suquamish Tribe and the Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe. The MOU is from 2008 and precedes each Tribe joining on as a signatory to the Inter-Local Agreement (ILA) as associate members. Questions were raised about whether the MOU is a relevant document anymore, and whether the ILA supersedes or replaces it.

Chair Gelder will reach out to the Chairmen of the Suquamish Tribe and the Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe to discuss the MOU and determine whether the agreement is still useful, and whether it should be updated and renewed.

Discuss effort to reach to re-engage Tribes' participation in KRCC

KRCC values the participation and perspective of the Suquamish and Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribes. Chair Gelder will reach out to Tribal leaders to discuss dues and participation.

Discuss Triangle annual review

This evaluation functions as a performance review for Triangle Associates, Inc. who provides KRCC staffing support. In past years, the Chair and their jurisdiction's support staff (rather than KRCC staff) have administered the survey to ensure objectivity. KRCC staff will update the form for 2023 and will send a copy to Chair Gelder, who will work with County staff to set up a plan to administer the survey and manage responses.

Approve Triangle Associates August 2022 Invoice

Mayor Erickson made a motion to approve August 2022 invoice of \$5,968.00. Mayor Deets seconded the motion, which passed without objection or abstention.
