
▲ Accessory dwelling units (or ADUs) come in many shapes and styles.

Why ADU's?

- Provide housing option to 80 120% Area Median Income
- Disperses housing throughout a community
- Available Land = Reduced Cost
- Generally, provides housing for one to two people


National Average





How Much Do Preapproved Plans Cost?

• Orland, CA: \$30,000

• Olympia, Tumwater, Lacey: \$50,000

• Leavenworth: \$60,000





Is it working?

- Most popular in Seattle or Portland
- Generates lots of inquiries
- Pre-reviewed not necessarily pre-approved
- A tool that is politically neutral
- Often outside of builders construction comfort zone
- Cost of construction very high
